



### Only Trump Voters

- 17. Did President Trump's promise to "conduct the largest mass deportation operation in American history" make you more likely or less likely to vote for him in 2024 election for president? **More Likely: All 82.0%; Hispanic 75.5%**
- 18. President Eisenhower launched the largest deportation effort in U.S. history, which resulted in around one-third of illegal migrants leaving the country. Do you support or oppose President Trump's goal of exceeding that effort? **Support: All 86.7%; Hispanic 78.9%**
- 19. If President Trump exceeds one million deportations of illegal migrants in 2026, are you more likely or less likely to vote for the Republican candidate in the November general election for Congress? **More Likely: All 74.0%; Hispanic 75.2%**

### Immigration Enforcement/Mass Deportations

- 20. Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "The first duty of the American government is to protect American citizens, not illegal aliens." **Agree: All 76.2%; Hispanic 71.8%**
- 21. Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "Immigration to the United States is a privilege, not a right. America has the right to decide who may enter our country and who may not." **Agree: All 77.8%; Hispanic 70.0%**
- 22. Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "Immigration policy should serve the interests of American citizens." **Agree: All 82.2%; Hispanic 77.3%**
- 23. Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? "America has an obligation to enforce the immigration laws Congress enacts." **Agree: All 79.7%; Hispanic 68.0%**
- 24. Entering the United States illegally is a crime. Do you support or oppose [the statement that] any migrants who enter the country illegally should be deported? **Support: All 66.1%; Hispanic 58.7%**
- 25. Currently, over 1.6 million illegal migrants remain in the United States despite having been issued final orders of deportation by a federal judge. Do you support or oppose the government immediately deporting these individuals to ensure our laws are respected? **Support: All 66.1%; Hispanic 57.3%**
- 26. Do you support or oppose deporting foreign tourists and other temporary visitors to the United States who remain here past the expiration date of their travel visas? **Support: All 64.7%; Hispanic 54.2%**



## Employment

- **27.** It is unlawful for U.S. employers to hire migrants who are in the country illegally. Do you support or oppose penalizing employers that violate this law? **Support: All 71.0%; Hispanic 60.0%**
- **28.** Do you agree or disagree that businesses that repeatedly violate immigration hiring laws should face escalating penalties? **Agree: All 76.9%; Hispanic 67.2%**
- **29.** To ensure jobs are reserved for legal residents and prevent the exploitation of migrant workers, do you support or oppose the federal government conducting regular audits and enforcement actions at businesses that knowingly hire illegal migrants? **Support: All 71.6%; Hispanic 62.4%**
- **30.** Do you support or oppose strengthening workplace immigration enforcement to help raise wages for American workers? **Support: All 70.3%; Hispanic 62.0%**
- **31.** Do you support or oppose the federal government notifying employers when their employees' social security numbers don't match government records, so employers can take action to ensure they are not employing illegal migrants? **Support: All 82.3%; Hispanic 74.4%**
- **32.** Do you support or oppose allowing the IRS (Internal Revenue Service) to fine employers that hire illegal migrants? **Support: All 69.4%; Hispanic 59.3%**
- **33.** Do you support or oppose requiring all employers to use the free online tool E-Verify to verify that people being hired are authorized to work in the United States? **Support: All 77.9%; Hispanic 72.1%**
- **34.** Should big corporations be allowed to benefit from cheaper illegal migrant labor, when that labor is subsidized by American taxpayers, who pay for their education, health care, and other benefits? **No: All 73.8%; Hispanic 67.3%**
- **35.** Is it fair or unfair for the wealthy to benefit from illegal migrant labor while the working class has to compete against illegal migrant labor? **Unfair: All 80.3%; Hispanic 71.7%**
- **36.** Do you agree or disagree that the federal government has put the interests of illegal migrants above the interests of poor Americans, including veterans and the elderly? **Agree: All 52.2%; Hispanic 50.5%**

## Benefits

- **37.** Do you agree or disagree that failure to enforce immigration laws places additional strain on local schools, hospitals, welfare services, and first responders? **Agree: All 66.8%; Hispanic 57.8%**



- **38.** Do you support or oppose deporting illegal migrants in the United States who rely on taxpayer-funded welfare benefits? **Support: All 69.5%; Hispanic 60.4%**
- **39.** Should migrants residing in the United States illegally have access to our financial system, including banks? **No: All 56.5%; Hispanic 41.6%**
- **40.** Congress recently passed a law putting a 1% tax on certain money transfers that illegal migrants send back to their home countries. Do you support or oppose increasing that tax and applying the tax to all money transfers by illegal migrants back to their home countries? **Support: All 59.3%; Hispanic 58.4%**

### **Cooperation**

- **41.** Do you agree or disagree that all federal agencies, including the Department of Homeland Security, the IRS, and the Social Security Administration, should cooperate in the enforcement of immigration laws? **Agree: All 73.2%; Hispanic 64.3%**
- **42.** Do you agree or disagree that protesters who attack or harass law enforcement officers while they are enforcing the laws passed by Congress should be arrested and prosecuted? **Agree: All 66.5%; Hispanic 56.0%**
- **43.** Do you agree or disagree that state governments should share information on illegal migrants with the federal government? **Agree: All 68.3%; Hispanic 55.8%**
- **44.** Do you support or oppose cutting off federal funding to sanctuary cities that release criminal illegal migrants into their communities rather than handing them over to federal law enforcement for deportation? **Support: All 56.4%; Hispanic 52.0%**

### **Wrap-up**

- **45.** The Biden administration focused only on removing violent criminals. Do you support or oppose expanding enforcement to include all deportable migrants who are in the United States illegally, including visa overstays and those with final deportation orders, to ensure no one is above the law? **Support: All 58.3%; Hispanic 50.7%**
