Methodology



McLaughlin & Associates

McLaughlin and Associates conducted a survey among 2,000 likely voters between February 27 – March 3, 2026.

All interviews were conducted online. The interview distribution and demographics reflect a 2026 general election turnout model.

The accuracy of the sample of 2,000 likely voters is within +/- 2.2% at a 95% confidence interval. The numbers in this presentation have been rounded and may not equal 100%.



Executive Summary



Economic Issues, Especially Inflation, Dominate But Addressing Illegal Immigration Remains Important


- Three in five (62%) are economic issue voters with inflation/cost of living (41%) as the dominate singular issue. It is the number one issue across the board.
 - The other individual issues are fragmented, including economy/jobs (12%), immigration/border (10%), national security/war-peace (10%), and healthcare (10%).
 - Immigration/border increases in importance among voters who approve of Trump (22%), Trump voters (17%) and Republicans (17%).
- Although affordability dominates, addressing illegal immigration is an important priority to nearly three-quarters (72%), including 42% who say it is “very” important.
 - The level of importance and intensity increases among Trump approvers, Trump voters, and Republicans.
 - It’s important to two-thirds of Independents and undecideds.



Trump Voters Were & Continue to Be Highly Motivated By Deporting Illegal Immigrants; Big GOTV Opportunity

- In the 2024 presidential election, 4 in 5 (82%) Trump voters were more likely to vote for Donald Trump because of his promise to conduct the largest mass deportation operation in American history. The majority (57%) was highly motivated (much more likely) to vote for him.
- Trump voters universally support (87%) the President exceeding the previous largest deportation effort led by President Eisenhower, which resulted in around one-third of illegal migrants leaving the country. The support has intensity with the majority (61%) “strongly” supporting it.
- If President Trump exceeds one million deportations of illegal migrants in 2026, three-quarters (74%) of Trump voters would be more likely to vote for the Republican candidate for Congress. The majority (53%) would be “much” more likely to vote for the Republican candidate. Clearly, this accomplishment would energize Trump’s base to come out and vote Republican.

Majority Consensus on Immigration Principles

- Four in five (82% to 13%) agree that immigration policy should serve the interests of American citizens. Roughly half (47%) “strongly” agrees.
 - The consensus is universal among Trump voters and Republicans, reaching 94%, but there is broad agreement among Democrats (71% to 21%) and Independents (81% to 13%). Agreement is wide and only 8-points higher among White voters (85% to 11%) than Hispanics (77% to 17%).
- Over-three-quarters (78% to 18%) believe immigration to the United States is a privilege, not a right, and America has the right to decide who may enter our country. Half (50%) “strongly” agrees.
 - There is near unanimous agreement among Trump voters (94% to 5%) and Republicans (95% to 4%). The vast majority of Independents (79% to 15%) and a clear majority of Democrats (60% to 36%) agree. Although higher among White voters (81% to 16%), 7 in 10 (70% to 24%) Hispanics agree.
- Three-quarters (76% to 20%) agree that the first duty of the American government is to protect American citizens, not illegal aliens (President Trump’s SOTU statement). The majority (52%) “strongly” agrees.
 - This principle generates the highest levels among Trump voters (96% to 3%) and Republicans (97% to 3%). Agreement is bipartisan with three-quarters of Independents (74% to 20%) and the majority of Democrats (57% to 39%). The opinion of Hispanics (72% to 25%) is similar to White voters (78% to 19%).
- The majority (52% to 40%) sees a problem. They believe the federal government has put the interests of illegal immigrants above the interests of poor Americans, including veterans and the elderly. One-quarter (27%) “strongly” agrees.
 - There is a partisan divide among Trump voters (75% to 19%) and Republicans (73% to 21%) compared to polarized Independents (48% to 42%) and Democrats who disagree (58% to 34%). Agreement is similar among White voters (53% to 40%) and Hispanics (51% to 42%).




Majority Consensus on Illegal Immigration Law & Order

- Four in five (80% to 15%) believe America has an obligation to enforce the immigration laws Congress enacts. Close to half (46%) “strongly” agrees.
 - Trump (93% to 5%) and Republicans (93% to 5%) universally agree. Broad agreement is bipartisan with two-thirds of Democrats (64% to 27%) and 4 in 5 Independents (81% to 11%). Although stronger among White voters (83% to 12%), over two-thirds of Hispanics agree (68% to 25%).
- Over three-quarters (77% to 18%) agree businesses that repeatedly violate immigration hiring laws should face escalating penalties. Nearly half (47%) “strongly” agrees.
 - There is bipartisan agreement. It’s highest among Trump voters (92% to 6%) and Republicans (93% to 5%) followed by Independents (76% to 16%) and Democrats (62% to 31%). Four in five White voters (80% to 15%) and two-thirds of Hispanics (67% to 27%) concur.
- Nearly three-quarters (73% to 19%) believe all federal agencies should cooperate in the enforcement of immigration laws, including 46% who “strongly” agree.
 - Trump voters (94% to 3%) and Republicans (94% to 3%) are in near unanimous agreement. Roughly three-quarters (73% to 17%) of Independents agree. Democrats are more divided, but a majority agrees (52% to 37%). Approximately two-thirds of Hispanics (64% to 29%) and over three-quarters of White voters (77% to 16%) agree.
- Over two-thirds agree on three law and order statements: state government should share information on illegal migrants with the federal government (68% to 24%); protestors who attack or harass law enforcement officers while they are enforcing the laws passed by Congress should be arrested and prosecuted (67% to 26%); and failure to enforce immigration laws places additional strain on local schools, hospitals, welfare services, and first responders (67% to 27%).
 - Trump voters and Republicans universally agree. Close to two-thirds of Independents are aligned while the statements are polarizing among Democrats. Although the agreement is higher among White voters, a clear majority of Hispanics are in consensus.

Two-Thirds Support Fundamental Deportation Policies

- Two-thirds (66% to 27%) support deporting migrants who enter the country illegally. Two in five (41%) “strongly” support it.
 - Nine in ten (90% to 9%) Trump voters and Republicans support it, 3 in 5 (62% to 25%) Independents favor it, and Democrats are divided (45% to 48%).
 - Although higher among White voters (68% to 25%), 3 in 5 Hispanics (59% to 35%) support the deportation policy.
- Two-thirds (66% to 27%) support immediately deporting the 1.6 million illegal migrants who have been issued final deportation orders. Two in five (40%) “strongly” support it.
 - Nine in ten Trump voters (92% to 5%) and Republicans (93% to 5%) support it, nearly two-thirds of Independents (63% to 26%) favor it, and a slight majority of Democrats oppose it (51% to 42%).
 - Over two-thirds of White voters (69% to 24%) and the majority of Hispanics (57% to 36%) support it.
- Two-thirds (65% to 28%) support deporting foreign tourists and other temporary visitors who remain in the country past the expiration date of their travel visas.
 - The vast majority of Trump voters (86% to 10%) and Republicans (87% to 10%) support it, 3 in 5 (62% to 28%) Independents favor it, and Democrats are polarized (44% to 48%).
 - Although higher among White voters (67% to 26%), the majority of Hispanics (54% to 38%) support the policy.



Broad Majority Support for Workplace Illegal Immigration Policies


- Over two-thirds, ranging from 69% up to 82%, support illegal immigration policies in the workplace.
 - 82% support the federal government notifying employers when their employees’ Social Security numbers don’t match government records. The majority (51%) “strongly” supports it.
 - 78% support requiring all employers to use the free online tool E-Verify to verify that people being hired are authorized to work in the United States. Nearly half (47%) “strongly” favors it.
 - 72% support the federal government conducting regular audits and enforcement actions at businesses that knowingly hire illegal migrants, including 41% who “strongly” support it.
 - 71% support penalizing employers that violate laws by hiring migrants who are in the country illegally, including 43% who “strongly” approve it.
 - 70% support strengthening workplace immigration enforcement to help raise wages for American workers. Two in five (41%) “strongly” support it.
 - 69% support allowing the IRS to fine employers that hire illegal migrants, including 41% who “strongly” back it.
- The workplace policies are extremely popular among Trump voters and Republicans. There is bipartisan support among two-thirds of Independents and the majority of Democrats. Support is stronger among White voters, but the majority of Hispanics favor the policies.


Voters Oppose Exploitation of Illegal Migrant Labor

- Three-quarters (74% to 13%) believe big corporations should NOT be allowed to benefit from cheaper illegal migrant labor, when that labor is subsidized by American taxpayers, who pay for their education, health care, and other benefits.
 - The sentiment is strong across the board, including two-thirds agreement among Democrats (65% to 17%) and Hispanics (67% to 20%).
- Four in five (80% to 13%) consider it unfair for the wealthy to benefit from illegal migrant labor while the working class has to compete against illegal migrant labor.
 - The perception of unfairness is widespread across all demographics.

Should Big Corporations Be Allowed to Benefit from Cheaper Illegal Migrant Labor




Wealthy Benefiting from Illegal Migrant Labor While Working Class Has to Compete



Broad Support to Deport Illegal Migrants Who Rely on Taxpayer Funded Welfare


- By a 3 to 1 ratio (70% to 23%), the vast majority supports deporting illegal migrants in the United States who rely on taxpayer-funded welfare benefits. Roughly half (47%) “strongly” supports it.
 - There is universal support (90% to 9%) among Trump voters and Republicans. Over two-thirds (69% to 19%) of Independents favor it while Democrats are more polarized (49% to 42%).
 - Three-quarters of White voters (74% to 19%) and a clear majority of Hispanics (60% to 35%) support it.




Do you support or oppose deporting illegal migrants in the United States who rely on taxpayer-funded welfare benefits?

Majority Opposes Illegal Migrants Having Access to U.S. Financial System

- The majority (57% to 28%) opposes illegal migrants having access to our financial system, including banks.
 - Over three-quarters of Trump voters (78% to 12%) and Republicans (76% to 13%) oppose the access. The majority of Independents (58% to 22%) disapprove, but Democrats lean in favor of giving access (47% to 35%).
 - The majority of White voters (60% to 24%) oppose the access while Hispanics are polarized (43% yes to 42% no).



- Three in five (59% to 27%) support increasing the 1% tax on money transfers made by illegal migrants and applying the tax to all money transfers sending money back to their home countries.
 - Four in five (81% to 10%) Trump voters and Republicans support it. The majority of Independents (54% to 27%) support it while Democrats tilt against it (44% to 42%).
 - The majority support is similar among White voters (60% to 25%) and Hispanics (58% to 33%).



What do you think is the MOST important issue facing the country today, that you would most like to see the President and Congress deal with to help you and your family?



How important of an issue is addressing illegal immigration in deciding your vote for congress?











Do you support or oppose deporting illegal migrants in the United States who rely on taxpayer-funded welfare benefits?





Should migrants residing in the United States illegally have access to our financial system, including banks?









Do you agree or disagree that protesters who attack or harass law enforcement officers while they are enforcing the laws passed by Congress should be arrested and prosecuted?





Do you agree or disagree that state governments should share information on illegal migrants with the federal government?






